THE SEASON

This year's harvest stands out as one of the best in the past decade - allowing for perfect harvest conditions.

The Indian summer allowed for an even, slower ripening period, producing highly concentrated fruit with distinctive flavours. As a result, the wines are pure and powerful, with lifted aromatics, lively acidity and great energy.

HARVEST

Grapes were organically grown on the steep slopes of our high density planted Brookby Hill Vineyard in the Southern Valleys of Marlborough.

WINEMAKING

The fruit for our Field Blend was hand harvested, whole bunch pressed, and co-fermented. The wine was then aged on light yeast lees for six months to gain complexity and increase mouthfeel.

TASTING NOTES:

Our Field Blend wine is a perfect combination of freshness and vibrancy with multiple layers of texture. It boasts delicate aromatics, featuring the scent of fresh cut wild flowers, apricots, and lemon thyme. It has a waxy mouthfeel and a subtle white pepper finish. This wine is delightful on the palate, with texture, weight and richness.
